

REQUIREMENTS FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION (39 HOURS)

- A. **REQUIRED CORE COURSES:** Complete 24 hours from the following:
1. Complete 15 hours from: HPCP 199, 299; ARTH 335, 338; HPCP 415.
 2. 3 hours from: ARTH 265; HIST 211.
 3. 3 hours from: URST 310.
 4. 3 hours from: HPCP 410; HIST 496; URST 400.
- B. **ADDITIONAL Courses:** 6 hours from: ARTH 105, ARTH/HPCP 275; HPCP 315, 319, 420; HIST 323.
- C. **ELECTIVES:** 9 hours FROM ANTH 202, 351, 493; ARTH 260, 333, 339, 394, 395; ARTS 119, 215; ECON 307; HPCP 339; 490 HIST 214, 216-217, 221-222, 224-225, 256, 301, 303-307, 354-357; POLS 305, 381; URST 201, or relevant Special Topic courses in ARTH, HPCP, HIST, POLS or URST.
- D. At least 15 hours of 200+ level Historic Preservation major courses must be taken in residence at the College of Charleston.
