Requirements of Concentration Options:

THESIS Option:

- 6 hours of African-American oriented history

- 6 hours of African-American oriented thesis

- 9 hours of African-American oriented history
- 3 approved hours in another discipline
- 3 hours of African-American oriented independent study or research seminar.

Three hours of independent study on an African American topic may be included as part of the nine hours of course work.
