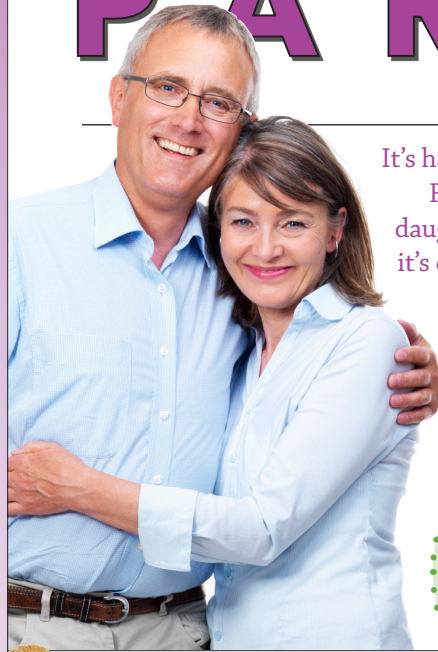

All students must earn a minimum grade point average (GPA) to avoid being placed on academic probation. Because official notification that they've been placed on probation isn't sent until the end of the semester, it's always a good idea for students to monitor their own progress.
