The College of Charleston Spring semester in Trujillo, Spain offers students the opportunity to study with faculty from CofC and from the Universidad de Extremadura. Students pay a program fee and CofC tuition for the semester. All financial aid and scholarships apply. Students will enroll in 12-15 credit hours.

Trujillo is located in the Extremadura region of Spain, southwest of Madrid, about 60 miles from the Portuguese border. A thriving center of tourism with a rich historical past, Trujillo is the place of origin of many conquistadors, including the Pizarros. Cáceres, a UN designated World Heritage City and the site of the Universidad de Extremadura, lies about an half hour west of Trujillo. Classes are held in the Coria, a 17th century restored convent, from Monday through Thursday, allowing students ample time for excursions and internship work. Students will live with host families in Trujillo. Families are handpicked each year and the majority of families house students each Spring semester.

Dr. Elaine Griffin holds a Ph.D. in Spanish Linguistics and has directed many spring and summer study abroad programs, both to Trujillo and to Santiago, Chile. Dr. Celeste Lacroix, Associate Professor of Communication, will teach (in English) Communication courses. Dr. Lacroix has co-directed the Trujillo program on several other occasions. She has also co-directed a summer study abroad program in Communication to Austria, Germany and Italy for the past two summers.

College of Charleston students will live with families in Trujillo, offering them an extraordinary opportunity to improve fluency in Spanish and to experience Spanish culture firsthand. There will be excursions throughout Spain, including visits to Madrid, Mérida, Guadalupe, Toledo, Sevilla, Granada and Córdoba. After the semester finishes, students may choose to travel around Spain and Europe on their own.

The program fee of **\$4,795\*\*\*** includes:

- Round-trip airfare from Charleston to Madrid.
- Room and board with families for the duration of the semester.
- Hotel accommodation and two meals a day during planned excursions.
- Entrance fees to museums and historic sites while on planned excursions.
- Study Abroad Medical Insurance.
- International Student Identity Card.

**\*\*\*Tuition is NOT included in this fee. You will pay your normal full-time tuition with the College of Charleston.**

The application deadline is **October 12, 2007**. A deposit of \$250 must accompany the application. This includes a non-refundable application fee of \$50.
