### Course offered:

**THTR 489: The English Speaking Theatre in London (3)**

This course will be a thorough immersion into the world of the performing arts in Great Britain, focusing on the theatre scene of London. Additional study trips will be made to Cambridge and Bath Spa, with an optional weekend in Stratford-on-Avon, home of Shakespeare and the Royal Shakespeare Company. Lectures will be supplemented and illustrated through visits to museums, major architectural sites and West End theatres. The course will combine an historical overview of theatre in Britain and the English-speaking world with opportunities to view current plays and exhibitions. Daily classes will include lectures (including guest lectures from London's theatrical community, backstage and museum tours, and, most frequently, walking tours of London districts, focusing on theatrical, historical, and architectural sites of note.

Evan Parry, Associate Professor of Theatre, is Head of the Performance program at CofC. A professional actor, director, and fight choreographer, he will lead the tour to Stratford-on-Avon as well as discussions of theatrical performances to be seen in London. He will also conduct numerous London walking tours. Professor Parry is also the Artistic Director of The Shakespeare Project. This is the seventh study abroad program that he has directed.

\*\*Program fee includes a non-refundable \$50 application fee (for CofC students), roundtrip airfare, hotel accommodations in central London, day trips, theatre and museum admissions, international medical insurance, and international student ID card, optional weekend in Stratford-on-Avon is NOT included.

Application and a deposit of \$550 are due **February 29, 2008**. Scholarships of up to \$1000 are available for CofC students. Eligibility is based on demonstrated financial need and academic merit.
