

PSYCHOLOGY DEPARTMENT - Job Announcement

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR(S). The Department of Psychology at the **College of Charleston** invites applications for **two** tenure-track positions at the assistant professor level to meet the needs of an expanding department and enhance our undergraduate research program. All positions will begin August 15, 2009. First position: **Developmental Psychology.** We are seeking a developmental psychologist to teach courses in developmental psychology, introductory psychology, and related courses. Preference will be given to candidates with research programs that focus on developmental processes in infancy, childhood, or adolescence, and to those candidates who demonstrate a commitment to excellence in teaching and who involve undergraduates in research. Review of applications for the developmental position will begin October 1, 2008. Second position: **Cognitive Psychology.** We are seeking a cognitive psychologist to teach courses in human cognition (lecture and lab), introductory psychology, and related courses. Strong preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate a commitment to excellence in teaching and involve undergraduates in research. Review of applications for the cognitive position will begin November 1, 2008. A Ph.D. in psychology is required for all positions.

The College of Charleston and Department of Psychology have a strong commitment to achieving diversity among faculty and staff. We are particularly interested in receiving applications from under-represented groups.
