- * ***JR STANDING IS REQUIRED FOR ALL 300 AND 400 LEVEL BUSINESS-SCHOOL COURSES & ALL PREREQUISITES MUST BE COMPLETED.***
- * ***MAJORS MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 50% OF THE REQUIRED CREDIT HOURS FOR GRADUATION OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS.***
- * ***AT LEAST 50% OF MAJOR COURSES MUST BE TAKEN AT THE COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON.***
