- \* **ECON 201 & ECON 202 WILL SATISFY THE SOCIAL SCIENCE REQUIREMENT.**
- \* **MGMT 105 OR FINC 120 IS RECOMMENDED BUT NOT REQUIRED. IT WILL FULFILL ELECTIVE CREDIT.**
- \* **SOPHOMORE STANDING IS REQUIRED FOR ECON, ACCT, AND BLAW 200 LEVEL COURSES.**
- \* **JR STANDING IS REQUIRED FOR ALL 300 AND 400 LEVEL BUSINESS-SCHOOL COURSES & ALL PREREQUISITES MUST BE COMPLETED.**
- \* **MAJORS MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 50% OF THE REQUIRED CREDIT HOURS FOR GRADUATION OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS.**
- \* **AT LEAST 50% OF MAJOR COURSES MUST BE TAKEN AT THE COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON.**
