- \* ***NATIVE SPEAKERS MAY BE REQUIRED, UPON INSTRUCTOR'S APPROVAL, TO SUBSTITUTE FREN 313, 314, AND 350 WITH A 400 LEVEL COURSE.***
- \* ***STUDENTS MAY HAVE NO MORE THAN SIX HOURS TOTAL OF DIRECTED READING AND INDEPENDENT STUDIES.***
- \* ***FOR FOREIGN LANGUAGE COURSES THAT RANGE FROM 101 TO 202, SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A HIGHER LEVEL COURSE PROHIBITS A STUDENT FROM TAKING A LOWER LEVEL COURSE IN THE SAME LANGUAGE FOR CREDIT.***
